It is such an honor to be able to come alongside so many people and journey with them through their hardest times and support and celebrate with them as change, healing and transformation takes place in tangible ways!

One of the groups coming for sessions this summer is from Aurora Residential Alternatives. Their program provides community-based living solutions and innovative brain injury care in Colorado. They help adults who have experienced traumatic brain injuries from car or motorcycle accidents, domestic violence, etc., and they support and encourage them to achieve their highest level of independence and well-being.

They provide innovative, person-centered services that empower individuals to thrive, and part of this now involves bringing groups and individuals out for equine sessions with us!

What a privilege to be able to work with this group!

The first two groups from this program were asked to choose 3-5 items ranging from what they felt would be the least scary to the most scary. In order, they then had to introduce the items to the horse and then, like they would with their hand or a brush, they had to pet the horse all over with that item and then lay it on the horse.

The items that felt the most uncomfortable or frightening to the person, because of how they handled those items, didn't phase the horses. Used differently, that same item had the potential to scare or hurt the horse, but instead, each item was used carefully and the horses never moved!

The overall message was that sometimes when something seems challenging or uncomfortable or produces anxiety, approaching it from a different perspective and handling it in a different manner, makes all the difference and can actually build trust!
